OSH Bangladesh Industry Outlook 2024

The growing safety concerns coupled with mandatory provisions in workplace safety, and steady growth have driven the Fire Safety equipment and Personal Protective equipment market in Bangladesh. The Fire safety equipment market is growing at 15% annually. The market size is estimated it to be more than Tk 5,000 crore annually. The turnover in refilling fire extinguisher cylinders is more than Tk 500 crore. Some of the Bangladeshi companies such as PRAN-RFL Group and Partex, manufacture safety equipment such as fire

doors, however, they are thinking of manufacturing more safety equipment, considering their rising demand. Recently, PRAN-RFL partnered with a UK-based company, Life Co, for all industrial equipment solutions. They manufacture fire doors and assemble fire extinguisher cylinders in Bangladesh. Also, the exports of personal protective equipment (PPE) in Bangladesh recorded a sharp gain of 23.39 % to USD 618 million in

the fiscal year 2020-21 while Intertek and BEXIMCO opened a USD 100 million PPE plant at BEXIMCO HEALTH, PPE Industrial Park, Dhaka in Bangladesh in 2021.
